

EXHIBITOR QUICK TIPS

We are looking forward to having you join us at our 2nd annual Summer Showcase Charity Horse Show taking place June 28-30 at the Westmoreland County Fairgrounds in Greensburg, PA! We are anticipating over 100 horses on the grounds and lots of fun to be had—all for a great cause. Below you will find some information about the show and what to expect so you can prepare for the competition ahead.

GENERAL INFO AND MOVE-IN DAY

- ALL HORSES ON THE GROUNDS MUST PRESENT THE OFFICE WITH A CURRENT COGGINS.
- Move-In day is Friday, June 28th. No one may enter the grounds before 11:00 AM
- Camping on the grounds required pre-payment to reserve your spot. The spots themselves, however, are first come first serve.
- The entry booth will be open from 3 PM until end of show on Friday evening for class registrations and then open at 7AM each show morning.
- Guests are encouraged to bring lawn chairs or picnic blankets
- No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the grounds.
- Dogs are welcome on leashes.

CONCESSIONS AND FOOD TRUCKS


- We will be selling soft drinks and water at the concession stand all weekend long. Cash only.

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SHOW DAYS

- Patterns are available <u>online</u> and in limited printed quantities at the entry booth.
- The show starts promptly at 8AM each morning. Our barrel exhibition will not begin before 5PM on Friday evening.
- ALL barrels/poles competitors must wear a long sleeve shirt and ALL barrels/poles exhibitors under the age of 18 years old MUST wear a helmet.
- EWD maximum support is a WALK ONLY class. EWD Independent and Minimum supports are W/T classes.
- Smallfry riders CANNOT cross enter into W/T/C classes. They can, however, enter any open W/T class.
- Leadline classes are for children 7 & under. They may show both days and may enter in western or English attire for both days.
- All entries are non-refundable and are considered donations to the Making Strides Foundation.
- The judge and horse show committee are responsible for and have final say regarding any discrepancies during the competition.
- Our horse shows staff is made up of VOLUNTEERS. All proceeds of this horse show benefit the Making Strides Foundation to keep out-of-pocket costs low for the families that we serve. Our ZERO TOLERANCE policy prohibits harassment, abuse, and discrimination of any kind towards our staff, exhibitors, spectators, horses, etc. Fun and safety are our number one priority at this horse show.
- There is an EMT on site for the duration of the competition, on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
- In case of inclement weather, there is an covered arena available.
